



**Town Manager's Report
September 19, 2018**

I met with FAA and DOT in Augusta to discuss scoping out the next project at the airport—taxilane reconstruction between the 100 and 200 hangar blocks. The meeting was lengthy, but seemed to be productive. We also will be working with a new Gale representative who, thus far, seems to be knowledgeable and capable of working to the Town's advantage.

Jim Lord of Dirigo Engineering met with Ranger Construction in order to develop a punch list of items that needed to be completed before clearing the Ward Hill Road project. This list has been satisfactorily completed and the engineer recommends approving tonight's pay requisition. Wellman Paving is planned to be on site within three weeks for the paving portion of the project. In the short-term, the Town is responsible for dust control on Ward Hill.

We have received our SafetyWorks! Report back from Maine Bureau of Labor and are working diligently to resolve hazards before October 17. We will be issuing a written response to each hazard and intend to address each concern as soon as possible.
