**INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS:**

Mark a cross (X) or checkmark (✓) in the square at the left of the name of the candidate or response for which you wish to vote. Follow directions as to the number of candidates to be voted on for each office. You may vote for a person whose name does not appear on this ballot by writing in his/her name in the proper blank space, marking a cross (X) or checkmark (✓) in the proper square to the left and, for indicated offices, writing in also the municipality of residence of the person of choice. Do not erase names.

To have your vote count, do not erase or cross out your choice.

If you made a mistake, ask for a new ballot.

**QUESTION 1: FULL-TIME FIREFIGHTERS**

**To see if the Town will vote to authorize the hiring of two full-time Norridgewock Fire Department firefighters, to be installed no earlier than July 1, 2020, and to raise and appropriate \$50,000.00 to cover the cost of these new positions.**

*Board of Selectmen recommends a YES vote, 3-2  
Budget Committee recommends a YES vote, 4-2*

A 'YES' vote supports the hiring of two full-time Norridgewock Fire Department firefighters

A 'NO' vote opposes the hiring of two full-time Norridgewock Fire Department firefighters

**QUESTION 2: SPEED TABLE REMOVAL**

**To see if the Town will vote to require the removal of the speed table on Upper Main Street and to prohibit the installation of future speed tables unless otherwise approved by the Legislative Body.**

*Board of Selectmen recommends a NO vote, 4-1  
Budget Committee recommends a NO vote, 5-1*

**YES**  **NO**

A 'YES' vote supports the removal of the speed table on Upper Main Street and prohibits the speed tables from being installed unless approved by a vote of Town Meeting.

A 'NO' vote leaves the speed table on Upper Main Street in place and does not create any future restrictions on installing future speed tables.
